Pupil Premium at Greenfield in 2015-2016 was used to support a range of intervention programmes including:

- Additional teacher for ability sets in Mathematics from Year 1 to Year 6
- Additional 0.5 teacher to support Pupil Premium children in Key Stage 2
- Learning Support Mentor (social groups, 1:1 IEP work, mentoring)
- Extra 1:1 tuition
- Additional teaching assistant in Reception (EYFS)
- Achievement for All programme for all Pupil Premium children
- Intervention Groups in Year 3 (Mission Possible), Year 4 (Lego WeDo), Year 5 (Greenfield United) and Year 6 (Quest)
- Nurture Intervention Group in Key Stage 1
- Educational visit and residential subsidies
- Additional teaching assistant support for phonics, reading and writing
- Individual and small group music lessons
- Curriculum enrichment and after school clubs

Pupil Premium at Greenfield in 2015-2016 will be used to continue to support these strategies, all of which have proved to be highly effective and have impacted positively on academic and wider outcomes for our Pupil Premium children. Additionally we have introduced a new Nurture Intervention Group in Key Stage 1, Super 8, and a new Intervention Group in Year 3, Mission Possible.
