



## Greenfield Primary School Pupil Premium Impact 2016-2017

Pupil Premium at Greenfield in 2016-2017 was used to support a range of intervention programmes including:

- Additional teacher for ability sets in Mathematics from Year 1 to Year 6
- Additional 0.5 teacher to support Pupil Premium children in Key Stage 2
- Learning Support Mentor (social groups, 1:1 IEP work, mentoring, Emotional, Well-being, Mindfulness & Resilience Groups Morning 'Meet and Greet' session)
- Support from Educational Psychologist
- Extra 1:1 tuition
- Additional teaching assistant in Reception (EYFS)
- Achievement for All programme for all Pupil Premium children
- Intervention Groups in Year 3 (Dirty Dozen), Year 4 (Mission Possible), Year 5 (Lego WeDo), Year 6 (Greenfield United)
- Nurture Intervention Group in Key Stage 1
- Circle Time Peacemakers throughout the whole school
- Subsidised educational visits and residentials
- Additional teaching assistant support for phonics, reading and writing
- Individual and small group music lessons
- Curriculum enrichment and after school clubs
- Release time for Structured Conversations
- Open Sessions – targeted invitation
- Parental support

Pupil Premium at Greenfield in 2017-2018 will be used to continue to support these strategies, all of which have proved to be highly effective and have impacted positively on academic and wider outcomes for our Pupil Premium children. Additionally we shall introduce more innovative interventions, yet to be named.
