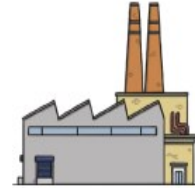

Beach	an area of sand sloping down to the water of a sea or lake	Valley	a long depression, or ditch, in Earth's surface
Coastline	a line that forms the edge between the land and the ocean or a lake	City	A large town. Manchester and London are cities
Forest	A large area filled with many trees	Town	A thickly settled area that is usually larger than a village but smaller than a city
Mountain	A mountain is a landform that rises high above its surroundings. It is taller than a hill.	Village	a place where people live that is usually smaller than a town
		Harbour	a deep body of water that protects boats near land
