Muhammad and the Mosque

Vocabulary	
Muslim	A person who follows and believes in Islam.
Islam	The religion or faith followed by Muslims.
Mosque	Place of worship used by Muslims.
Qur'an	Holy book which Muslims believe was revealed to Muhammad.
Crescent moon and star	Often used as a symbol of Islam.
Allah	Arabic word for God.
Muhammad	Founder of Islam. Believed by Muslims to be the final prophet sent by God.
Prophet of God	A person who has been given messages by God to pass on to other people.
Makkah	The holiest city in Islam. Where Muhammad was born.
Night of Power	The night when Muslims believe that the Qur'an was revealed to Muhammad.
Angel Jibril (Gabriel)	The angel sent by God to Muhammad with the message of the Qur'an.
Dome	The large, curved roof to be seen on most mosques.
Minaret	The tower that forms part of most mosques.
Revelation	God's messages to Muhammad.

The story of the "Night of Power".

1. Muhammad was alone on the mountain.
2. The angel Jibril (Gabriel) appeared to him.
3. Words appeared to Muhammad.
4. Muhammad memorised and understood the words exactly.
5. Muhammad taught the words to others exactly as he had memorised them.

Muhammad received many further revelations. Muslims believe these revelations are God's words and are the content of the Qur'an.
