ENGLISH

This term's class texts are as follows:

Y3 Malta: Charlotte's Web,
Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters
Bluebird.

Y3/4 Sri Lanka: The Railway Children
and Journey

Y4 Canada: Stig of the Dump, The
Firework Maker's Daughter, and Every
Child a Song

Over the term, we will use our class
texts as a stimulus for writing
stories, non-fiction texts and poetry.

With spelling, we will continue to
focus on rules and patterns, and we
will help the children improve their
writing and editing skills.

MATHS

Year 3 will be focusing on fractions,
time, shape, and Mass &

Capacity. Year 4's will focus on
decimals, money, time, statistics,
shape and position & direction.

The children will also have frequent
opportunities to develop their fluency
and their mental maths skills, applying
them purposefully.

DT

In the second half term, the children
will learn more about electrical
circuits and build a working
lighthouse model.

PE

The children will develop their
balancing skills and agility. They will
also develop their knowledge and
skills in playing team games such as
rounders and cricket. They will
develop their athletic skills when
preparing for Sports Day.
Pupils in Malta Class will be developing
their swimming technique this term.

GEOGRAPHY

This term's topic has a geography
focus. The children will learn
about the main mountains and
rivers of the world, how mountains
are formed and their climates.

They will learn why people settle
by rivers from both a physical and
human geography perspective.

The children will also find out
about the human impact on coasts
and develop their fieldwork skills.



FRENCH

The children will be learning
vocabulary to be able to tell and
act the story of Cinderella
(Cendrillon) in French. Later, they
will be listening to the music of
Carnival des Animaux by Camille
Sans-Saëns and learning
vocabulary to name and describe
animals.

PSHE

This term the children will be
learning about healthy choices and
habits, personal strengths and
achievements and how to overcome
setbacks. They will learn about
risks and hazards in the local area
and unfamiliar places.

MUSIC

We will explore singing three-part
songs with repeating patterns. The
children will also learn to sing
songs with call and response
features and percussion
accompaniment.
Canada Class will be learning how
to play a brass instrument.



SCIENCE

This term the children will learn
about plant life cycles. They will
learn more about the function
of flowers, including pollination,
seed formation and dispersal.
They will also learn about living
things and their habitats. They
will look at how changing
environments can pose a threat
to the living things that live in
those regions.

RE

The children will be learning
about the importance of rules
and where many rules come
from. Later, they will be
learning about the holy book of
Islam, the Qur'an and its origins
as well as its role and
importance within Islam.

COMPUTING

This term children will focus on
collecting data and information
and using data loggers. They will
recognise how and why data is
collected over time, before
using data loggers to carry out
an investigation.

In addition, the children will
explore sequencing sounds by
creating sequences in a block-
based programming language to
make music.

ART

The children will be using a
variety of art materials to
create observational drawings
of fruit and vegetables before
designing a clay tile. In the
second half term, they will look
at creating textures and mark
making to create paper collages.
