What is a Miracle?


A miracle is: 1. Something that fills you with wonder.

2. A welcome event that cannot be explained by science.

Many Christians believe that miracles are evidence of God's power and that God cares for people.

Jesus is described performing miracles in the Bible which Christians believe shows that Jesus came from God and had God's powers.

Key words	Definitions
miracle	An extraordinary event which cannot be explained by science. Often understood by Christians as showing the power of God.
resurrection	Christians believe that Jesus rose from the dead after being crucified. This is considered by Christians to be the greatest miracle of all.
New Testament	The second part of the Bible where stories about Jesus can be found.
healing	Making people well and healthy. Jesus is described as having healed people who had diseases and disabilities in the Bible.



Bible stories

<u>Feeding the 5000—</u> Jesus is able to feed a huge crowd with just the lunch brought by one small boy, two fish and 5 loaves of bread.

<u>Healing a paralysed man</u> - A group of men bring their friend who cannot walk or move from his bed to Jesus, who is able to heal him and make him walk again.
