
Who was Jesus?

Key words	Definitions
Messiah	The Hebrew word for a saviour or king like person. Many Jews in Jesus's time were waiting for a leader to save them from Roman rule and lead them to peace.
Christ	A title or name for Jesus. It expresses the Christian belief that Jesus was both God and man.
Judea	The country in the Middle East where Jesus was born.
Christian love or agape	Also known as unconditional love. Showing kindness to another person not requiring anything in return. May require elements of self-sacrifice
sacrifice	Giving up something in order to achieve something greater and more important.

<u>Peter's Confession</u> - Peter (one of Jesus's main disciples) said that he believed that Jesus was "the Christ, Son of the living God"
