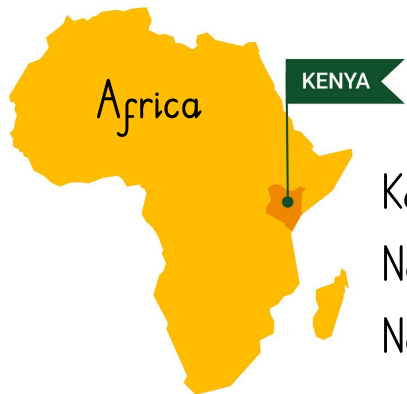






















# Comparing the physical and human features of the UK and Kenya

Important Words	
<b>human feature</b>	A feature that has been <b>made by a human</b> .
<b>physical feature</b>	A feature that has been <b>made by nature</b> .
<b>similarity</b>	Something that is the <b>same</b> .
<b>town</b>	An area larger than a village but smaller than a city. Stourbridge is a town.
<b>city</b>	A large area where lots of people live close together. A city is bigger and more important than a town. London and Birmingham are cities.
<b>village</b>	Usually, a small group of houses in the countryside. A place that is smaller and less busy than a town.
