Average Progress Scores

Reading	2.5	Significantly above average
Writing	0.7	
Mathematics	2.0	Significantly above average

These scores show how much progress pupils at this school made in reading, writing and maths between the end of key stage 1 and the end of key stage 2, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1. The national average score is zero. A positive score shows where pupils made better than average progress.

The scaled score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

Mathematics	50%	Significantly above average
In Reading, Writing AND Mathematics	25%	Significantly above average
