### The Easter Story

Easter is the most important festival in the Christian calendar. It celebrates Jesus rising from the dead, three days after he was executed.

#### The key events of Holy Week



##### **Palm Sunday**

Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and the crowds waved palm leaves.



##### **Maundy Thursday**

At the Last Supper, Jesus washed the feet of his disciples.



Jesus went to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane.



##### **Good Friday**

Jesus was crucified and he died on a cross.



##### **Easter Sunday**

Jesus rose from the dead – he was resurrected

Key Words	
<b>crucifixion</b>	The word used to describe Jesus’s death on the cross.
<b>resurrection</b>	The word to describe the Christian belief that Jesus rose from the dead - came back to life.
<b>sacrifice</b>	To do something that includes hardship and suffering so that something good can be achieved.
<b>Christ</b>	The name given to Jesus. Some Christian beliefs about the name Christ: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Jesus was Christ.</li> <li>2. Jesus was truly God and truly man.</li> <li>3. Jesus is often called the ‘Son of God’.</li> </ol>
<b>Messiah</b>	The title given to the person believed to be the Saviour. Christians give this title to Jesus.
<b>Saviour</b>	Someone who saves people from danger or harm. Many Christians believe that Jesus saved all of mankind.
