Types of Christian Prayer	
Adoration	Praising God for His greatness
Confession	Admitting to a sin or wrongdoing and asking for forgiveness.
Thanks giving	Thanking God for His blessings- health, family etc
Petition	Asking God for help with something- healing, courage etc
Intercession	Asking God to help others who need it- the poor, the homeless, refugees, etc.

Key Words	
worship	Showing love, respect and adoration to something or someone of worth.
chanting	Speaking the words from memory to a rhythm
reciting	Repeating the words exactly again and again from memory
hymn	A song of praise and worship to God
mantra	A word or sound repeated to help focus and meditation
adhan	Muslim call to prayer
Lord's Prayer	Christian prayer shared by Jesus in the New Testament
Shema	Jewish prayer
amen	The ending of a Christian prayer meaning "I agree" or "so be it"
puja tray	Tray containing the artefacts need for Hindu worship
artefact	An object which is sacred- important to a religious believer and is often used in their worship
sacred	Special and holy.
